## **AMCOM** commander meets, speaks with Future Soldiers

**REDSTONE ARSENAL, Ala.** – Maj. Gen. Todd Royar, the commander of the U.S. Army Aviation and Missile Command, will meet with Future Soldiers (those who have or are about to enlist, and haven't attended basic training yet).

WHAT: In support of National Hiring Days, Maj. Gen. Todd Royar will meet with 30-40 Future Soldiers to discuss why these young men and women are joining the Army and to answer their questions about military service.

WHEN: June 7, starting at 9:30 a.m. Media interviews with Maj. Gen. Todd Royar, Staff Sgt. Jeremy Henry, Recruiter, and 30 to 40 Future Soldiers.
