

AMCOM G-1 HUMAN RESOURCES



The U.S. Army Aviation and Missile Command G-1 supports AMCOM employees, supervisors, deploying contractors, assigned active-duty Soldiers and mobilized Army Reservists. They provide policy and guidance on military and civilian human resource management, and serve as the change consultant and strategic partner to meet AMCOM strategic initiatives to recruit, develop and sustain a top-performing workforce. AMCOM G-1 is also responsible for maximizing AMCOM's recruitment power, providing innovative solutions to attract, recruit and retain a professional workforce to support the needs of the warfighter.

The AMCOM G-1 Director's Office and Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC) provide coordinated support for 28 organizations with more than 800 Soldiers located at Redstone Arsenal and the Huntsville, AL area. The team provides each Soldier the advantage of a centralized office for military human resources, non-technical training, readiness, in- and outprocessing, leaves, passes, permissive TDY, awards, personnel actions, military pay and entitlements. AMCOM G-1 also facilitates the local Army Physical Fitness Test, Army Warrior Training, Army Weight Control Program, Medical Readiness, Army Command Policies, family readiness, as well as deployment oversight and assistance.

MISSION: To provide AMCOM with innovative and accessible strategic human capital management programs and services for Soldiers, civilians and family members worldwide. Collaborate with internal and external stakeholders to recruit, develop, sustain and manage a top-performing workforce.

The HHC Commander is designated as the AMCOM Uniformed Code of Military Justice Authority.
