



AMCOM G-4 LOGISTICS



MISSION: Enable AMCOM mission success by providing integrated environmental, facilities and property accountability to ensure the readiness and maintainability of weapon and support systems.

The U.S. Army Aviation and Missile Command G-4 Internal Logistics provides AMCOM master planning, real estate, facilities (construction, repair, restoration, maintenance and management), environmental compliance, hazardous materials replacement, property accountability, energy, fire protection and environmental life-cycle support to ensure the readiness and maintainability of weapon and support systems. These efforts mitigate both current and future risks to weapon system sustainment activities/processes due to environmental, real property and property accountability issues.

G-4 HQ (Director, Deputy, and support staff):

The director is the principal staff engineer and advisor to the commander. The staff section plans and executes all financial, personnel, property and other administrative functions to support the G-4 mission.

Engineering and Property Division:

Contributes to the overall AMCOM mission by providing new facility construction, repair and restoration, real property accountability, facility and equipment management and engineering support worldwide. Internal Logistics manages AMCOM equipment accountability and non-tactical vehicle fleet. The G4 Sparkman Center Office manages facility and work orders, space management and access control.

Environmental Division:

Supports the procurement, readiness and maintainability of weapon and support systems by minimizing environmental and industrial hygiene risks associated with weapon-system development, production, operation, sustainment and disposal.
