MISSION: The AMCOM History Office establishes and maintains a historical program for the AMCOM commander that includes authoring historical publications, conducting historical research, conducting oral history interviews and answering historical inquiries.

History Office general information:

The AMCOM History Office provides history-related support to all staff levels of AMCOM, the aviation and missile program executive offices, Letterkenny Army Depot in Pennsylvania, the Aviation Center Logistics Command in Alabama, and Corpus Christi Army Depot in Texas. The History Office also pursues an enterprise approach to historical support to other Department of Defense and government organizations.

The History Office provides the following services to the command team and all AMCOM units:

- Publications in print and digital formats
- Access to an active records collection program that includes the digital preservation of records, photographs, oral interviews and historical videos
- Military history education, including a staff ride program
- Historical tours and project officers

- Lectures at schools and civic and professional organizations about AMCOM's history, U.S. Army heritage and military history
- Comprehensive answers to inquiries from the public, as well as local, national and international media
- Support work with local museums to create displays that highlight the accomplishments of AMCOM
